



Phased Reopening of Boomerangs Stores

Will Boomerangs stores be reopening? When?

Boomerangs is pleased to announce that our Central Square location will be reopening on September 2 as part of our phased reopening plan. The Central Square location is the second Boomerangs store to re-open and joins our Jamaica Plain location, which opened on July 1. Our South End store will be opening at a later date, still to be determined.

What will the hours be for your stores?

- **Jamaica Plain**—Now Open!
 - Senior Shopping: Monday–Friday from 10 AM–11 AM
 - Regular Shopping: Monday–Friday from 11 AM–6 PM
 - Saturday: 10 AM–6 PM
 - Sunday: Closed.
 - Donations: 11 AM–5 PM
- **Central Square**—Now Open!
 - Senior Shopping: Monday–Friday from 10 AM–11 AM
 - Regular Shopping: Monday–Friday from 11 AM–6 PM
 - Saturday: 10 AM–6 PM
 - Sunday: Closed
 - Donations: Wednesday–Saturday between 11 AM - 4 PM
All donations should come to the back door off of Norfolk Avenue.
- **South End**: Opening at a future date TBD.

Will all staff and patrons be required to wear a mask?

Yes. All staff and patrons are required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth at all times. Please understand that this protects both our staff and other shoppers. If you are unable to wear a mask, please consider shopping [at our online stores](#) instead.

Will there be limits to the number of people in the stores?

Yes. To encourage social distancing, we will limit the capacity of our stores.

Will social distancing rules be in effect?

Yes, social distancing is recommended under the Governor's orders. Shoppers are encouraged to maintain six feet of space between themselves and other patrons/staff. You will also see floor markers spaced six feet apart to help you maintain distance.



How will the stores be cleaned and disinfected?

We will be following the guidance from the CDC using EPA approved disinfectant to regularly clean high-touch surfaces, such as display tables, on a regular basis. We will be wiping hard surfaces throughout the store to reduce surface contact daily.

Are you still accepting donations?

Contactless Donations

We will be piloting a contactless donation system. Please sort your donations into the following categories: clothing (shoes, bags, belts, scarves, hats included), Media (books, CDs, DVDs, records), Kitchen and Household Decor, Art and Frames, and Jewelry.

Clothing can be bagged in kitchen-sized bags or larger. All other categories are best suited to being boxed—especially if they are fragile or sharp. We will have boxes to sort into if needed.

Furniture Donations

At this time, we are not accepting any large furniture or any upholstered furniture. Small furniture, furniture that can easily be carried by one person (like chairs or side tables) are acceptable. However, all furniture is subject to approval by our receivers. We hope that in the future we can begin to accept larger pieces of furniture. As always, we do not accept foot baths, humidifiers, air purifiers, bedding, exercise equipment, and undergarments.

We know this is a little extra work and inconvenience, on your end, but it will go a long way to help us keep our stores safe!

Has your merchandise been disinfected?

As we learn more about COVID-19 our understanding of how long it lives on surfaces has evolved. While the risk of contracting COVID-19 from contaminated surfaces is low, we will do our best to minimize any chance for surface contamination.

We are unable to individually wipe every surface and wash garments, instead, donations will be quarantined for a minimum of 24 hours before being brought to the sales floor.

Will your fitting rooms be open?

Per guidance from the state, all fitting rooms will remain closed during re-opening and potentially longer. All sales are final, but we will provide disposable measuring tapes to help you determine if clothes are a good fit.
